## Procedure to apply for registration for the (4)(2)(b) license under the Maharashtra Entertainment duty Act, 1923 by a Multi System Operator (MSO) or by a Local Cable operator (LCO)

- 1. The applicant is required to file for Registration of Entertainment tax as per (4)(2)(b) section of the Maharashtra Entertainment duty Act, 1923. Hence it is also known as the (4)(2)(b) license under the Maharashtra Entertainment duty Act, 1923 by a Multi System Operator (MSO) or by a Local Cable operator (LCO)
- 2. Registration of Entertainment tax can be an application by a Multi System Operator (MSO) or by a Local Cable operator (LCO)
- 3. The applicant has to register for a license from the home department and simultaneously registers with the Revenue Department
- 4. Once registered, the applicant files for Registration of Entertainment tax online on the Aaple Sarkar portal at <a href="https://aaplesarkar.mahaonline.gov.in/en">https://aaplesarkar.mahaonline.gov.in/en</a>
- 5. He/she selects the type of Registration as "New" or "Renew"
- 6. Then the applicant enters the required information in the application form and submits the form
- 7. After submission of the form, the applicant gets a unique application ID number which can be used to track his/her application
- 8. The applicant also has to submit a copy of his/her photograph and supporting documents online. The list of required documents can be obtained from the Aaple Sarkar website
- 9. Once the application is submitted, the investor can make a payment online. After a successful payment, the investor takes the payment receipt for document verification to the department
- 10. At the department, the application file is routed through three desks.
- a. In case, if there are gaps in the application, the investor is informed immediately and the information about gaps in the application is also posted on the portal
- b. Once the gaps are addressed, the Additional Collector uploads the Registration of Entertainment tax
